Why donate/fundraise?

What does Oak Bluff Home & School Association (OBHSA) do?

All funds raised/donated directly support OBCS students, teachers, and projects.

Thanks to your support, OBHSA provides funds for items not covered by the school's budget.

- **Classroom supplies** – every year, we offer \$20/student to each homeroom teacher!
- **Staff appreciation** – we recognize Teacher/Staff Appreciation Week on behalf of all families by providing OBCS staff with a catered hot lunch.
- **Classroom, gymnasium, and playground equipment** – occasionally, staff request funding (or funding assistance) for new equipment. OBHSA's playground task force is currently fundraising and seeking grants for new playground equipment.
- **Event equipment (audio/visual, chair rentals, etc.)** – this year, we provided funding assistance for chair rentals for the holiday concert, so that the teachers & students could keep their chairs in their classrooms during the school day.
- **School events** – occasionally, staff request funding (or funding assistance) for field trips or other events. OBHSA often donates funds to the Grade 8 farewell event (as requested by the students for decorations, etc). OBHSA also provides a hot dog lunch on Activity Day in June!
