1. My vehicle used for student transportation is rated appropriately and insured with a minimum Third Party Liability insurance of \$2,000,000.00.
2. My vehicle is properly equipped with seat belts for each occupant and that seat belts will be secured during transport.
3. I understand that Red River Valley School Division will not accept responsibility for any damage to my vehicle in the event of an accident, nor for the deductible, loss of insurance discount, or loss of use coverage.
4. I will ensure that, to the best of my knowledge, the motor vehicle used for student transportation is in good mechanical condition.
5. There is to be no smoking in the vehicle at any time while transporting students.

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6. I will abstain from alcohol, cannabis and any other restricted substances during my performance as a volunteer driver.
7. I will operate the vehicle in a safe manner and not in contravention of any statute or regulation governing the operation of motor vehicles.
8. I agree that I will not permit a child under the age of 13 years of age to occupy the front passenger seat of a vehicle equipped with a passenger seat airbag.
9. I will not use any hand-held electronic devices outlined in the Highway Traffic Act while driving students. Under Bill 5 of the Highway Traffic Amendment Act, this is illegal. For further details, refer to the Highway Traffic Amendment Act.
10. I understand that my physical and mental condition is critical to my ability to safely operate a vehicle. I have no physical or medical conditions that restrict my ability to drive, nor am I taking any medications that would impair my ability to drive.
